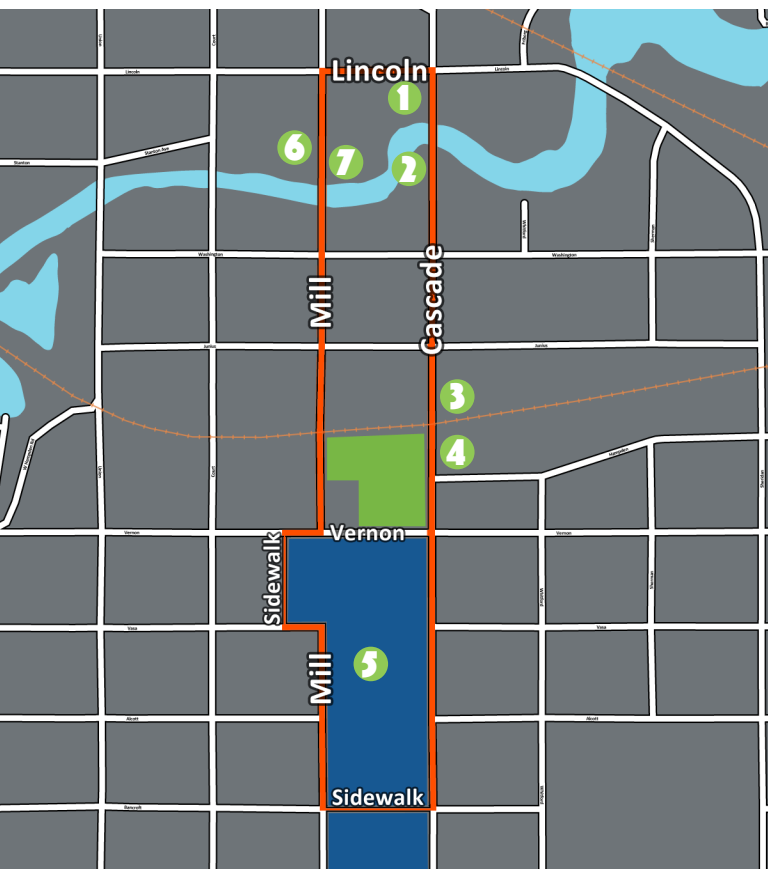

POINTS OF INTEREST

- 1 First National Bank Building**
Constructed in 1881, this was the city's first brick building. It later housed the Corner Bar, a longtime city institution.
- 2 Central Dam and Powerhouse**
Located where George Wright built the city's first dam in 1870, Central Dam generates 500 kilowatts of electricity.
- 3 Northern Pacific Depot**
Rebuilt in 1919 following the devastating tornado that swept through the city, the depot is undergoing a rebirth thanks to the efforts of local developers.
- 4 Public Library & NP Park**
- 5 Lake Region Healthcare Campus**
- 6 Edward J. Devitt Federal Building**
Originally half its current size, the 1903 post office was expanded in 1932 with a matching southern addition.
- 7 River Inn**
For years after its opening in 1929, the River Inn served as the social center of Fergus Falls. It now houses over 30 apartments and ground-floor businesses, including the Lake Region Arts Council.
