

SHIP News: Minnesota Alone Trims Obesity Rates Among Upper Midwest States

The Minnesota Department of Health recently publicized a news release stating that, due to the Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) grants, "Minnesota has outperformed nearby states by being the only one of its neighbors to bend the curve on obesity rates" (MDH).

The rate of Minnesotans at a healthy weight has increased since 2010, due to policy, system and environmental strategies which are the foundation of the Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) and its local community partners. SHIP is helping Minnesotans move more, increase access to healthy foods and reduce tobacco use & exposure.
